Starting in January 2013, Northern Clearing, Inc. removed trees, brush, and endless snow to clear 59 miles of right of way for Reed & Reed's Oakfield Wind Project during the winter months in Northeast Maine, in spite of a relentless record snowfall.



The scope of work included right of way clearing, access roads, matting, restoration, environmental oversight, and snowplowing.

CLEARING & PROCESSING

At peak, workers braved the winter conditions during the clearing of the right of way, averaging 5,400 feet per day, which included burning excess brush and timber each and every mile.

R.O.W. ACCESS MAT ROADS

More than 12,000 mats were required for this project, and were set, removed, and set again multiple times.

ENVIRONMENTAL

Northern Clearing, Inc. was in charge of environmental controls for the entire project, which was completed by March 14, 2015.
